THE DAILY SCHEDULE

A warm and entertaining **Morning Meeting** begins each day. This is a chance for the community to regroup, enjoy short skits presented by fellow campers or teen-assistants, sing together, and learn what the day's schedule will bring.

The Campers are then split into groups by age for the **Morning Workshops.** Each group is named after a theatrical lighting instrument. "Mini-Spots" are kids going into 1st and 2nd grade. "Footlighters" are those going into grades 3 & 4. "Ghost Lights" are those going into grade 5. "Gels" are those going into grade 6 and "Cycloramas" are the oldest group, going into grades 7 & 8. These morning hours are devoted to a vast variety of exciting workshops. Take a look at the example to the left!

After a brown-bag lunch, we offer "Fiesta" where the campers can choose to join in the group game or sport, or work on a creative project, such as a scene with friends in the community room.

The afternoon is for **Organized Rehearsals** directed by the staff or a special performance and workshop with a guest artist.

FINAL PERFORMANCES

Campers will be using the morning classes to learn skills that they will need for performing. The afternoon rehearsals channel these skills into work on dramatic scenes, writing projects, musical theatre numbers, and many more pieces that will be performed for friends, family and the community at the end of camp. For 28 years we were honored to be performers at the Sweet Pea Festival and Farmer's Market, and we will be back at it again this summer!

MINI-SPOTS

For kids going into 1st and 2nd grade, this "Mini-Spots" half-day morning program will provide playful, creative fun. Mini-Spots remain together with their teacher for the half-day program, exploring beginning acting, storytelling, movement, music, and creative play of all kinds. Toward the end of the session, they too will have an opportunity to perform for the camp, family and friends.
